



Wembley is ideally located for people who are going places. With impressively fast tube and train services across London it's just 19 minutes to the shops of fashionable Bond Street, and for professionals it is 30 minutes to Liverpool Street and 34 minutes to Canary Wharf.

It's also easy to reach the national highways network. Just 12 minutes to the M1 which connects London with the North of England, and 25 minutes to the M40 connecting London to the M25, Midlands and the West Country.





Wembley the home of legends

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Wembley is the heart and home of English football and host to some of the most memorable concerts in history. Here stands the stadium of dreams whose graceful arch reaching into the sky is as much a part of the cityscape as Big Ben and the London Eye.

From the minute you arrive there is an unmistakable sense of excitement in the air. On this spot, thousands have achieved their dreams and millions of great memories have been forged. Instantly recognisable around the world, the new state-of-the-art stadium opened in 2007 and is the second biggest in Europe. On this hallowed ground football's greatest heroes and biggest names in music have thrilled the crowds and secured their places in history.

world stage. Wembley Park is home to national and international events including the Color Run when the streets come alive with runners raising money for charity. Held in Wembley Stadium, the 1984 Live Aid concert featured many of the world's greatest rock and pop stars raising money for famine relief in Africa.

The home of legends, this place is so steeped in its high-energy heritage, it's become a part of the fabric, embedded in its DNA. With the revitalisation of the area, history continues to be made and there's the opportunity now to become a part of the story at this growing new community.

Minutes away from the stadium, Wembley Arena is another of Wembley Park's historic landmarks and one of the UK's top performance spaces. The glamorous Art Deco building dates from the 1930s and was built for the Empire Games. Recently refurbished and brought right up to date, it's an impressive venue for audiences of up to 12,000 people, and provides the setting for some of the world's top acts in music and comedy, along with family shows and indoor sporting events. Managing the venue is world-leading live entertainment and sporting provider AEG, which adds the arena to its portfolio of venues that include the O_2 .

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Wembley Park epitomises the dynamism of London today. A heady mix of vision, energy and great individuality is combining to establish this place as a vibrant new community. It has all the advantages of quick and easy access to central London, and there's so much going on here it's already a destination in its own right. 



The vision for Wembley Park



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

A new green oasis in the city






Where the living is easy

This landmark building at Emerald Gardens has commanding views across Wembley Park to the stadium. An elegant addition to the landscape, Cedar House with its sleek, modern lines rises to 13 storeys and offers outside space for most apartments with balconies or timber-decked terraces.

Completing the building's distinguished look, the external finish is traditional brick, the handsome material that's been integral to London's architectural fabric for centuries. The richly textured dark brown brick contrasts with the pale gold aluminium window surrounds. The top three floors are clad entirely in the pale gold to finish the building with a distinctive crown.

Apartment interiors have been designed with impressive care down to the last detail. Reflecting how busy people want to live, there's open-plan living space and thoughtful touches including builtin storage space, contemporary lighting including downlights throughout, fiberoptic superfast broadband, smart meters to help keep energy bills low, and state-of-the-art security with CCTV and key-fob controls for main entrances.







most apartments. The neutral colour scheme and wood flooring make the perfect backdrop to your furniture and belongings so it's easy to add your own stamp of personality.




The open-plan living area layout makes entertaining easy and cooking sociable. Because it's the little details that make all the difference, kitchens are planned to make cooking effortless. Features


include high-quality, integral Bosch appliances, recycling facilities, hardwearing Silestone worktops and sleek, handleless kitchen cabinets.
